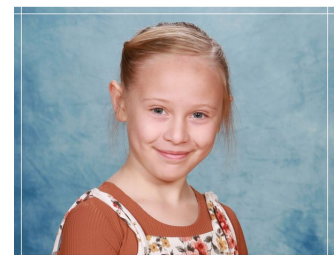
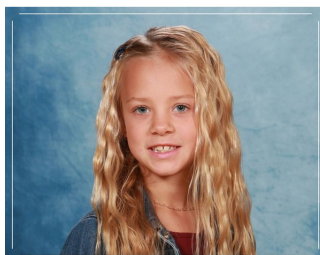
Staffing Update


Grade 1/2 ~ Martha Wiebe
