4. Trustee Report: Janel Vossler

AB Government announced funding after the Tumble Ridge incident to different divisions. This allows us to utilize funding for things such as security cameras, etc.

Complexity funding has already started to roll out in Irvine. There was 1 position allotted for Prairie Rose which was provided to the Irvine School.

Eagle Butte got new portables since they are at 98% capacity.

5. Principals Report

a. Leader Meeting Update - Did not get more staffing. Asked for more f/t EA hours.

Budget - Question was asked if we could use the current budget for additional support staff. Is it an option? Would doing more fundraising or getting donations contribute to that? - Mr. K to look into that since our budget is minimal and currently all accounted for.

- c. Badminton Update - Great season. Thanks to parents and students for putting so much effort into the season. Kids did amazing and received the Grade 7 banner as well as the banner for zones. A huge achievement for our small school that didn't even fill all of the categories but still earned the points. Mr. K has received emails giving credit to our athletes for doing so well.
