I highly encourage all parents to the link below for SchoolCash Online to pay for their school fees as well as any upcoming expenses.



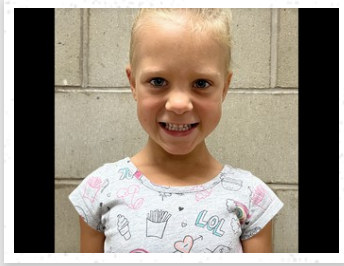
If your child is going to be absent at any time, please call the school at 403-839-3732. There is an answering service available 24 hours per day.

We will be following the same protocol as the end of last year if you are picking up or dropping off your child during the school day. Our doors are locked so please ring the doorbell or call to let us know you are here.



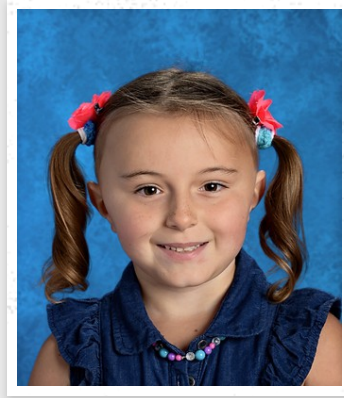
