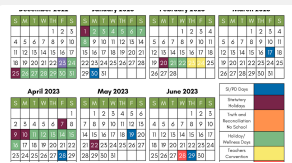

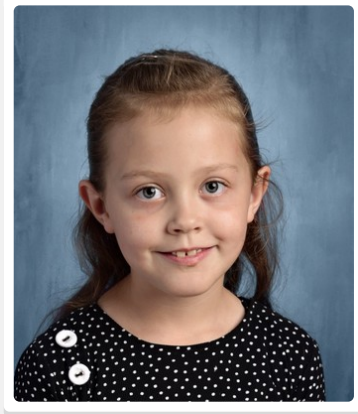
### **Kindergarten ~ Annie Herrmann**

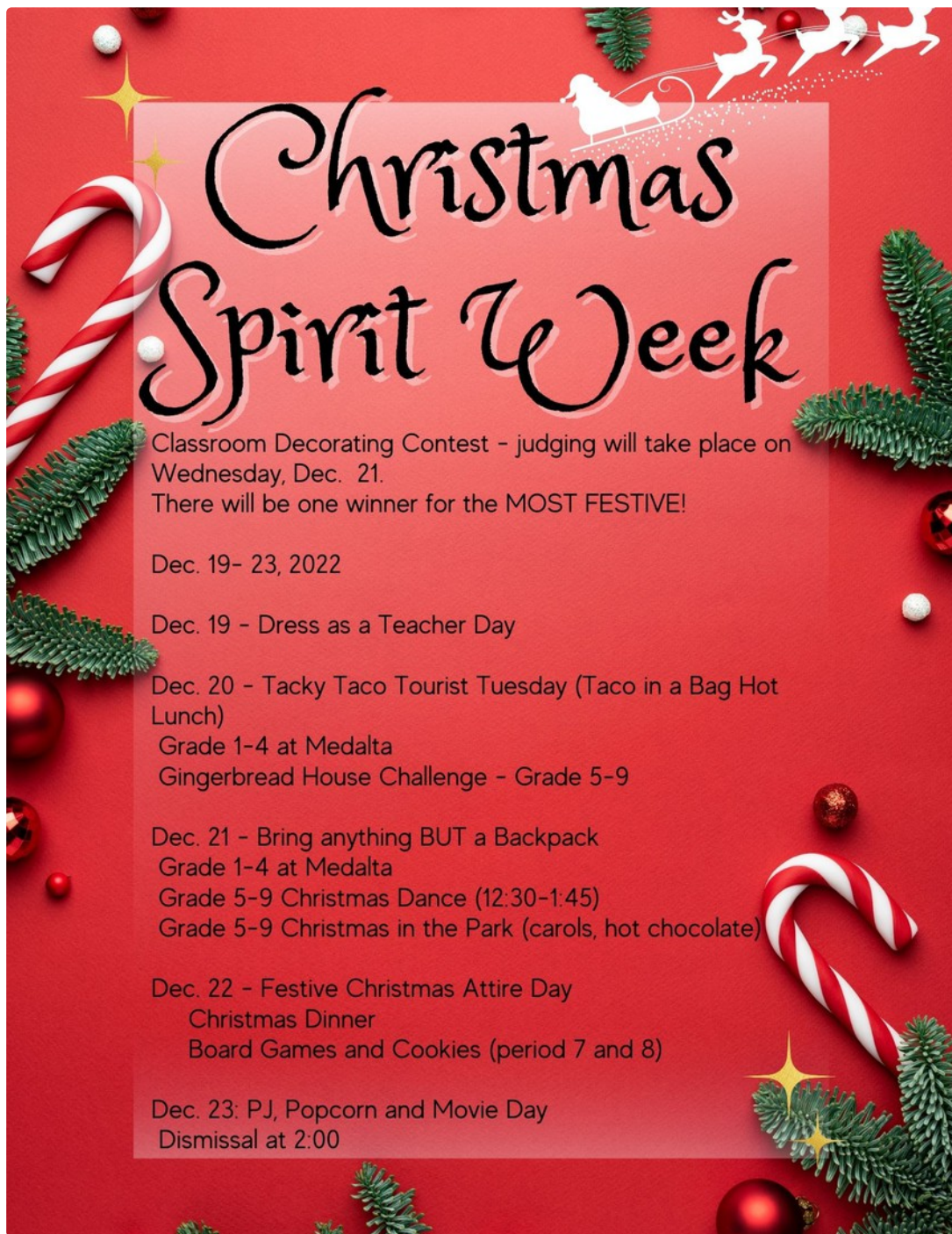
